Scene Summary:

9538 Keylsey Meadow Ct, Houston, Texas 77040 is a one story brick residence with a two car attached garage, located in the Windfern Subdivision, within Harris County Texas. Keylsey Meadow Ct is an unmarked two lane public roadway which travels east and west. The residence located on the north side of the roadway facing south.

Narrative:

On 12/23/2012, I, Deputy J. McCants, was dispatched to 9538 Keylsey Meadow Ct in reference to a homicide. Upon arrival, Cy-Fair Medic No. 1 was on the located in the master bedroom. EMS advised the victim was pronounced deceased at 1647 hours. The victim was later identified as Melgar, Jamie Estuardo, W/M, DOB 08/10/1960. Jaime was found lying on his back with his head towards the south and his feet toward the north. Jaime's body was in a slouched position with his upper shoulder area against the north side interior closet wall. Jaime was unclothed and had what appeared to be a jacket covering his genitals. Jaime's feet were bound together with a phone cord and what appeared to be a rope was found tossed on his arms and chest. Jaime appeared to have a knife wound to his abdomen. Outside the closet where Jaime was lying, was a chair next to the bed along with a medical bathing chair which had blood on them.

The bedroom appeared to have been ransacked with the dresser drawers open, the bed was positioned along the east wall and had several miscellaneous items scattered across it. There was a cell phone, a couple of blue jean pants and what appeared to be a females wallet and several shopping cards on the bed. Upon further notice the clothing in the drawers were still folded and appeared not to have been disturbed. There was a small drinking glass with sliced lemons located on the side of an exercise machine within the room.

In the master bathroom was a bathtub half full of water with a black handled butcher knife in it along with some clothing items. Along the tub was a glass bottle of liquor (alcohol) and a small drinking glass with sliced lemons in it, a bowl of strawberries and cream which had not been eaten. On the floor of the restroom were a couple of rugs, one looked to have been possibly torn. There was also several pieces of brown cloth material along the floor next to a cloth chair, the cloth material appeared to have been cut and was in several pieces.

Melgar, Sandra Jean W/F, DOB [REDACTED] was in the master bathroom laying next to the toilet crying. Sandra was wearing what appeared to be a black satin dress-like nightgown with a black satin robe, blue jean pants with pink and white socks. I asked Sandra what happened and she said she wasn't sure. Sandra said she was tied up in the closet and her sister-n-law (Melgar, Maria DelCarmen W/F, DOB [REDACTED]) found her and cut her loose. (The closet where Sandra was found is located in the master bathroom) I asked Sandra who tied her up and placed her in the closet and Sandra replied she doesn't remember. I told Sandra that it was very important that she calm down and try to remember what happened. Sandra said the last thing she remembered was her and her husband (Jaime) in the bathtub taking a bath together. Sandra said the dogs were barking and Jaime got out of the tub to put the dogs up. Sandra said she does not remember anything after that point.

I noticed Sandra wearing a night gown and robe, I asked if she was wearing the night gown last night and Sandra replied yes. Sandra said she was not wearing the pants that she placed them on after her sister-n-law untied her. Sandra said she wasn't feeling good and needed to use the restroom. Sandra while on the toilet complained of having diarrhea.

After Sandra's bowel movement, she was brought into the living room to have EMS check her well fair. Sandra said she periodically has seizures and black outs. Sandra said she wasn't feeling good and needed to go to the restroom. I then escorted Sandra to the secondary restroom where she complained of diarrhea again. After Sandra finished using the restroom she attempted to wash her hands, I stopped Sandra from washing her hands and advised her to allow her hands air dry. (no soap was used only minimum water) After Sandra's hands were dry

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brown bags were placed on her hands as standard procedure.

EMS medics checked Sandra's blood pressure and vital signs which came out normal. The area around Sandra's ankles and wrist where she showed she was tired up did not have any signs of injury or redness. Sandra immediately said she has a blood circulatory problems. Sandra was asked if she would like to be transported to the hospital for further testing and she said no. Sandra signed a refusal for the EMS medics.

During the investigation I asked Sandra if she locked the front and back door. She said yes but she did not set the alarm, and that she never sets it. I noticed there was a bucket of what smelled like Clorox and water in it along with a mop. The bucket and mop were located in the dinning room. I also noticed little pieces of shredded paper though out the residence, the shredded paper was also in the vacuum which was in the living room quarters.

I asked Sandra if she would voluntary give her consent to search and Sandra replied yes. Sandra signed a voluntary consent form which was later released to 61C35 Deputy Carpenter. To secure the residence Sandra was advised she would be placed in the back of the patrol vehicle. Sandra advised she needed to use the restroom again, I escorted her to the restroom and allowed her to use the restroom. Sandra was then placed in a patrol vehicle. During the interview Sandra never ask about Jaime.

Deputy Dennis advised that all the witnesses were placed into patrol vehicles which are listed below;
