At approximately 1640 hours on this date, I was dispatched to the listed address in reference to back up Deputy J.McCants, unit #4w13, to a possible man down call. Upon my arrival, I observed several people standing in the front yard, driveway, and across the street from the residence and a CyFair Fire Department Ambulance parked in front of the residence.

Upon entering the residence through the front door, I observed a hispanic male standing in the in the living room, who was later identified as the decedent's brother. I then observed a hispanic female leaving from the master bedroom, later identified as the decedent's sister-in-law. When I entered the master bedroom, I observed a male EMT and a female Paramedic from CyFair Fire Department and Deputy McCants looking at the deceased, who was lying in the master bedroom closet. I then returned to the front door and advised Deputy J.Burke, unit #4w37, to check for the brother and sister-in-law in the front yard and secure them. Cpl. G.Lopez, unit #8494, then checked the rest of the residence for suspects and found none.

I returned to the master bedroom where I found Deputy McCants and the female Paramedic in the master bathroom with a white female lying down in the water closet, who was later identified as the decedent's wife, Sandra. EMS personnel and Deputy McCants moved Sandra from the master bedroom into the den. While Sandra was sitting on the couch in the den, I was instructed by Cpl.Lopez to place Sandra's hands in paper bags for the protection of any possible evidence. I then secured the master bedroom until Sandra was removed from the residence and placed in my patrol car. At that time, the residence was secured by Deputy D.McCollough, unit #4w18, until Detective's and Crime Scene arrived. I stayed with my patrol unit, and checked on Sandra until I transported her to 601 Lockwood Dr. at approximately 2100 hours. Sandra was returned to the scene at approximately at approximately 0345 hours and released.
