Narrative

12:48 PM

The interview was complete and we left the location.

1:10 PM

Deputy Carrizal and I arrived at CVS Pharmacy located at 7710 Gessner to check video. We met with Ms. Lynette Forcht, store manager, who located video footage of the complainant entering the store location at approximately 9:25 PM on 12/22/2012. The footage showed the complainant then left the store at approximately 9:29 PM on that date. Deputy Carrizal advised Ms. Forcht that he would have a HCSO Video Laboratory deputy to contact her concerning the video.

3:06 PM

Deputy Carrizal and I arrived at the scene location of 9538 Kelsey Meadows Court. While at the scene, I met with a neighbor at the residence located next door at 9530 Kelsey Meadows Court. The neighbor, Ms. Odile Robertson, said that she and her husband were home on the night of the murder. She said her bedroom faced the complainant's back yard, and that the complainants' small dogs normally barked at night, which kept her awake. She said that she did not hear the dogs barking that night.

3:51 PM

Deputy Carrizal and I left the scene location.

4:36 PM

We arrived back at 801 Lockwood Drive. Deputy Carrizal advised that the complainant's daughter had called and said she found a strange bag inside the garage at the scene. She said it contained an X-Box game system that did not belong to the complainant.

5:26 PM

I contacted Deputy Campos, HCSO-CSU, and requested for him to meet us at the scene to collect the bag that Ms. Melgar spoke about.

6:03 PM

Deputy Carrizal and I arrived at the scene located at 9538 Kelsey Meadows Court, and met with HCSO CSU deputies R. Campos, Unit 61C22 and T. Kirkley, Unit 61C32. Upon meeting with Elizabeth Melgar and her husband, [REDACTED], Ms. Melgar said that upon looking further, she realized the X-Box and bag were property of the complainant's.

Deputies Campos and Kirkley processed the garage for latent prints in various locations. The evidence collected and processed was covered by Deputy R. Carrizal in his supplement.

8:51 PM

Deputy Carrizal and I left the scene location.
