Follow-up Investigation

I spoke with the victim Jaime Melgar's daughter Elizabeth Melgar and she stated the families rent home was damaged and there were stains in different areas of the home. The home was damaged by a recent tenant John Malbro and possibly Claudi James.

10:12 AM

On the above date and time, I requested a Crime Scene Unit at the home located at [REDACTED]. Sergeant Lovett advised CSU J. Noguera would respond to [REDACTED].

10:46 AM

I met with CSU Noguera upon arrival and shortly thereafter, the home owner, Elizabeth Melgar, arrived.

11:00 PM

Elizabeth Melgar gave written consent for the search of the home. I scanned the written consent in the ARS document E-file.

I requested Noguera to photograph the residence and swabs from certain areas inside. The residence was access through the rear door, which led into the garage. The residence was in poor condition with many damaged areas, and was extremely hot from being uninhabited.

CSU Noguera took photos of the residence, the overall dimensions of all the rooms, and four stain swabs from areas pointed out by the homeowner. I assisted by placing adhesive rule tape by all stains he wanted collected.
