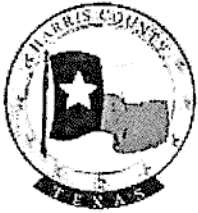

Latent Print Examination

On Thursday, July 06, 2017, Harris County Assistant District Attorney Colleen Barnett turned over to me five sheets of letter size paper with thirteen color photos printed on them. She advised that the photos were turned over by the defense counsel and were reported to be photos of the safe in the closet of the complainant's house. Included in the photos were close-up photos of the safe's handle which reportedly depicted fingerprint impressions. ADA Barnett requested I examine the images. I transported the papers to the CSU office and secured them in a Latent Submission envelope.

Upon examining the images of the safe handle I was not able to observe any latent impressions of value due to insufficient or no friction ridge detail.
