Before me, the undersigned Assistant District Attorney of Harris County, Texas this day appeared the undersigned affiant, who under oath says that he has good reason to believe and does believe that in Harris County, Texas, JARED COX, hereafter styled the Defendant, heretofore on or about JUNE 15, 2009, did then and there unlawfully with intent to commit theft, break into and enter a vehicle owned by NATHANIEL LEWIS, a person having a greater right to possession of the vehicle than the Defendant and hereafter styled the Complainant, without the effective consent of the Complainant, namely, without any consent of any kind.

Probable Cause

Affiant, Deputy P. Mikel, is a credible and reliable person who is a certified peace officer employed by the Harris County Sheriff's Office, has reason to believe and does believe that Jared Cox, hereafter the defendant, COMMITTED THE MISDEMEANOR OFFENSE OF BURGLARY OF A MOTOR VEHICLE IN HARRIS COUNTY, TEXAS ON OR ABOUT JUNE 15, 2009. Affiant bases that belief on the following:

Affiant spoke to the witness, Marcos Tamez, who stated that ON OR ABOUT JUNE 15, 2009, he was in his residence at 15519 STILLER PART, CYPRESS, HARRIS COUNTY, TEXAS when he heard his dog barking. He exited his residence and saw defendant wearing dark gloves, looking into a car, and attempting to open the doors of the car. Witness also saw Mr. David Carlson, hereafter styled the co-defendant, inside a vehicle that he knew to be his neighbor's vehicle. Witness asked co-defendant why he was in the car and co-defendant stated that the vehicle was his. Co-defendant and defendant then entered the same vehicle and defendant drove the vehicle from the scene. Witness told dispatch that the defendant and co-defendant left in a small black or blue vehicle with the beginning 3 numbers being "717." While en route to the scene and before speaking to witness, Affiant made a traffic stop of a small black vehicle with the beginning numbers of "717" after the vehicle did not stop at stop sign. The small black vehicle is registered to co-defendant. Affiant heard the call for service that identified a small dark vehicle with beginning license plate numbers "717" leaving the scene of a burglary of a motor vehicle. Defendant was observed to be wearing dark gloves by Affiant. Because of the proximity to the crime scene, similar characteristics of the small black vehicle and defendant wearing black gloves, Affiant then detained defendant and co-defendant for further investigation. Affiant returned them to the scene. Witness identified the co-defendant and defendant as the men he saw at the crime scene. Complainant, Mr. Nathaniel Lewis, indicated to Affiant that neither co-defendant nor the defendant have consent of any kind to enter his vehicle. While detained by affiant, defendant identified himself by name as Jared Cox, with a date of birth of 1/5/86.
